## D. Activities in 2020

In 2020, the EAGE student fund has executed or supported the following activities:

### Student Chapters

- 60 Student Chapters in 2020
- 949 sponsored student memberships
- Online Geo-Quiz 2020, Participants: 41 Student Chapters  
9 received the registration grant for the Annual Conference 2020 (online format)
- Best Student Chapter Prize to IFP School, France

### Student Lecture Tours

- The fund funded the visit of 12 lectures, one lecture was provided in the traditional format face-to-face, and 11 lectures in the online format.
- The e-Summit initiative launched - 7 events organized since April. This provided an excellent platform for students' engagement during the pandemic time.

With the support of Chevron, 50 registrations to Annual Online were offered, one student chapter geo quiz (Annual Online, Dec 2020)

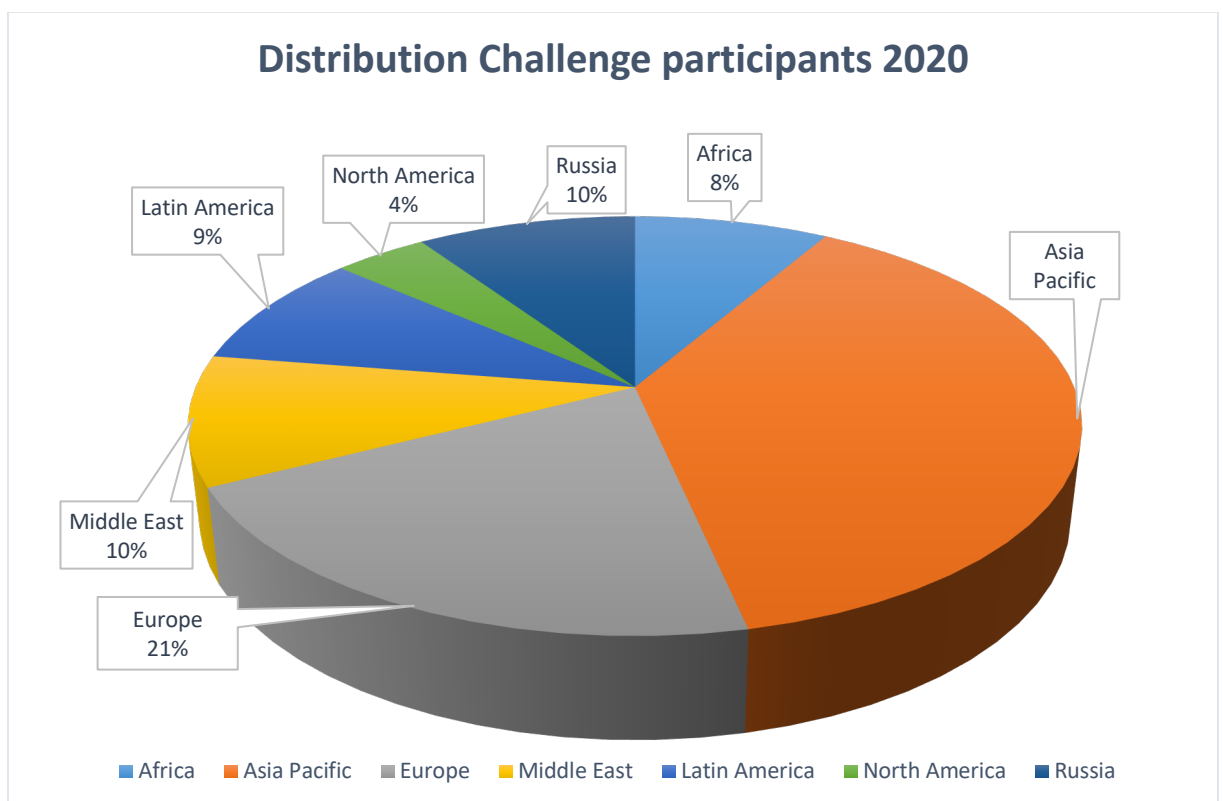

## E. Income and spending in 2020

The income in 2020 was lower than the 2019 income. This income is still low due to the pandemic situation that affects financially several industries. The board is contemplating a plan to raise more funds for the foundation.

The board of the Student Fund adapted the spending downwards in line with the development of the income of sponsoring and donations, but without specifically canceling any activities.

## F. Developments and future

- Following the first Covid-19 wave, various programmes were paused or moved online.
- Reinstatement of sponsored membership programme needed
- International travel will remain problematic. Therefore, no student travel grants yet
- Laurie Dake Challenge – online finals will be the format while the Covid 19 pandemic is restricting international travels.
- Continuation of online initiatives (student e-summit programme, online lecture tours)
- Encourage grassroots up student chapter online events - EAGE as facilitator & disseminator
